This is an ambitious plan, but it is the only remedy on the table that doesn't rely on the courts or lawmakers. This is a grassroots campaign to empower citizens to create fair maps that serve the interests of the people rather than politicians.

How can we get you the petition?

CHOSE AN OPTION

Once filled out, you must mail the petitions back to the post office box on the petition because original signatures must be submitted. Each petition can hold 10 signatures. Try to complete all 10, but it isn't necessary. Make sure that people print their name and date of birth clearly, as that's how the election commission will check to ensure the signer is a registered Richland County voter.
